# Announcement for a Specially Appointed Lecturer position at Muroran Institute of Technology

We are currently offering a Specially Appointed Lecturer position at Muroran Institute of Technology as detailed below.

- 1. Number of positions available: Specially Appointed Lecturer 1 [Full-time (Nontenured)]
- 2. Section: College of Liberal Arts / Linguistic Science and International Relations Research Unit
- 3. Specialty: English as a foreign language (EFL) education
- 4. Subjects to be taught:

Undergraduate School: Freshman English, English Communication, General English, English of the world (There is a possibility that the successful candidate may be asked to teach night-time classes.)

Postgraduate School: English presentation skills, Language and Culture A or B.

# 5. Requirements:

- (1) Candidates must have a bachelor's degree, preferably in a field related to education.
- (2) Candidates must be willing to take an active role in the educational management of both the undergraduate and postgraduate schools.
- (3) Any nationality is acceptable. However, candidates need to be able to teach undergraduate and postgraduate classes in English.
- (4) Candidates must be a native English speaker or have English language proficiency equivalent to a native English speaker.
- (5) Candidates must have minimum of two years English teaching experience at a university, college, senior high school, junior high school, vocational school, etc. in Japan.
- (6) Candidates must have sufficient Japanese language proficiency in order to undertake administrative tasks related to their educational activities.
- 6. Starting date: the earliest possible time on or after October 1, 2026
- 7. Salary: Annual Salary System (In accordance with the regulations on the annual salary system for specially appointed faculty members at Muroran Institute of Technology, a national university)
- 8. Contract period: Five-year fixed-term contract (non-renewable).

  - (6) Specialized knowledge and experience relating to your field of study. (Please specify your Japanese language skill. If you have a diploma related to English education, please specify).
- (3) (If relevant) Separate copies of three key papers (photocopies acceptable) along with a summary of each (approximately 200 words in English or 400 characters in Japanese for each paper).
- (4) (If relevant) Past research activities (approximately 500 words in English or 1000 characters in Japanese).
- (5) Your ambitions for future education (approximately 250 words in English or 500 characters in Japanese).
- (6) The names and contact information of two referees.
- (7) Your contact information (address, telephone number and email address).
- (8) An I.D. photograph (approximately 45mm x 35mm).

- 10. Deadline of application: All application materials must be received by November 20, 2025.
- 11. Selection method:
  - (1) First screening (of application documents).
- (2) Second screening (interview: topics will include applicant's ambitions for education, and teaching a sample lesson, etc.). The provisional interview date is in middle or late December, 2025. The applicant is responsible for their own transportation costs to the interview.
